2017 Music Magic Summer Violin Camp

Youth in Nelson County and the surrounding area are invited to a fun filled week long musical experience taught by experienced professional violinists to enhance the skills and confidence of experienced violinists or fast track learning for progressing beginners. Camp will be held daily, Monday through Friday June 12-16 at Rockfish River Elementary School during the week from 10:00 am – 12:00pm, with a final concert at 11:45 pm on June 16, 2017.

The camp is open to all violin students in grades 3 through 8. Students with at least 3 months of private lessons or 1 year of school orchestra experience are encouraged to apply. Students may attend the music camp for \$150, and scholarships and loaner violins are available on a limited basis. Class size is limited to 8 students with a minimum of 3.
